2. On the next screen enter your **full school email address** and your c2k password:

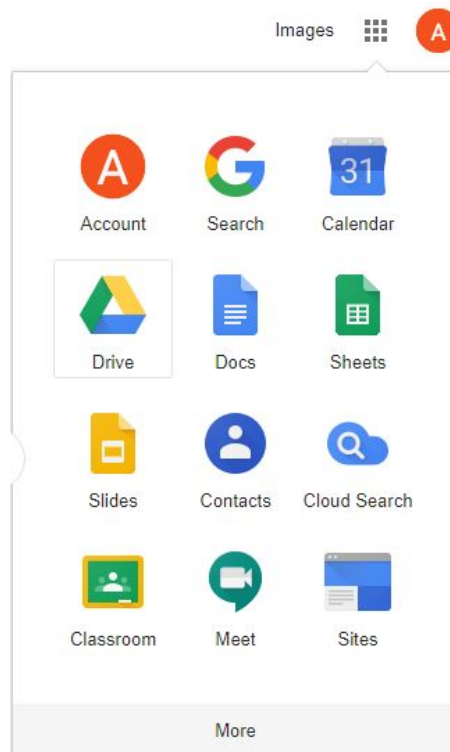

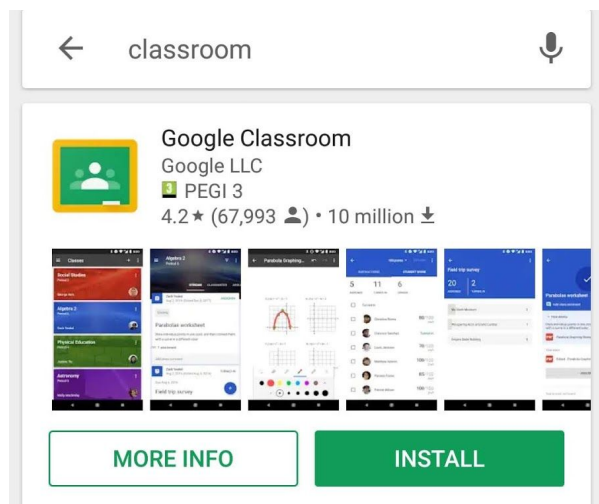

3. From there you are then signed into Google. You can click on the apps  icon and can use apps such as Drive and Classroom:

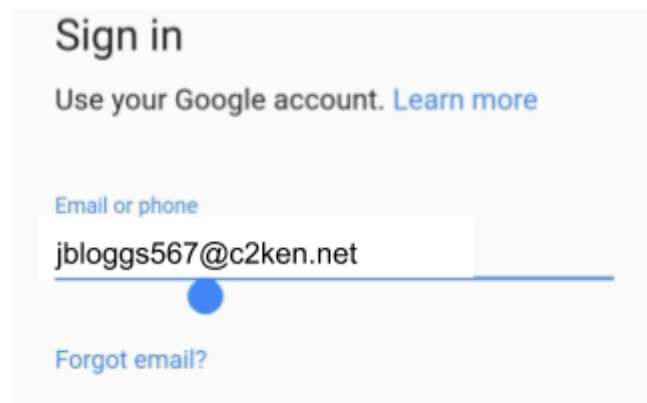


Accessing Google Apps Using School Account (On your personal device)

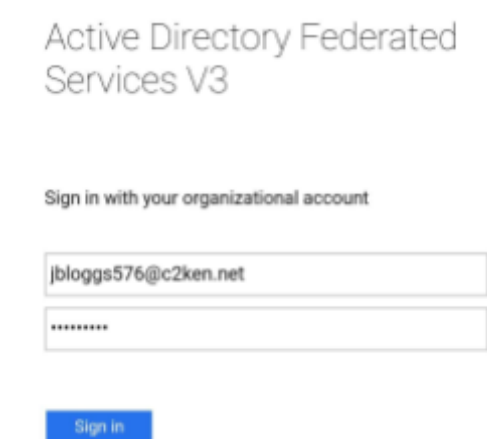
1. Download **Google Classroom** from the App/Play Store on your personal device



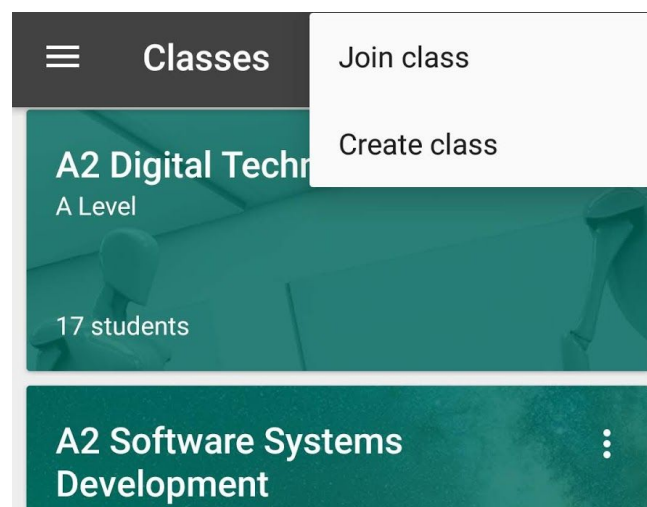
2. Open the app, add a new account and type in your **school email address** when prompted (c2kusername@c2ken.net)



3. Type your **school email address and password** on the “Active Directory Federated Services” screen.



4. You should now see any courses you are already enrolled on. To join more courses in the future you can click on the “+” icon.



5. You should also download the following apps as they may be needed to view/edit resources on Google Classroom:

- Google Drive
- Google Docs
- Google Slides



6. Remember any time you change/update your school C2K password, your apps will also require the new password.
