As you are aware the School's Centre Determined Grading (CDG) Policy was published to all parents and students, a copy is accessible on the School website via the following link

The policy clearly outlines the evidence that is being used to determine the CDG and all students should have received, via Google Classroom, the score/grade for each piece of evidence. As you have already been informed, we are unable to discuss with pupils and/or parents the Centre Determined Grades and/or how a score/grade in a piece of evidence equates to a particular CDG. Please be assured the School will continue to do everything possible to support our young people through this difficult period of time.

Parents are reminded that the Google Classroom area is a learning environment between the pupil and their teacher and must not be used to contact a teacher directly; all such contact will be ignored.
