
Accessing the Tracking Information

Load the Parent App or Pupil App on your phone or tablet device. If you are experiencing problems accessing the App please refer to the school website at the address below:

From the Home screen please tap the name of the student.



On the pupil screen tap Assessment.

A series of Grades and Scores (%) will be displayed.

You will need to scroll down to view all the information.

These Grades and Scores (%) are explained on the next page.

Understanding the Assessments

- The Pupil Target Grade is the grade which your son/daughter has indicated they are hoping to achieve.
- Two Tracking Assessments should be available displaying a Score (%) and a Tracking Grade derived from the score.
- The Tracking Grade is based on the Tracking Average. A score of 90% or more is awarded an A*, 80% or more an A, 70% or more a B, 60% or more a C, 50% or more a D and 40% or more an E grade.
- The Tracking Average is the average of the 2 Tracking Assessments in each subject.
- This information aims to give an indication of current performance to facilitate conversations at home regarding progress. However, each pupil has the potential to improve their performance through sustained effort and effective revision.
