The Rotary Club of Banbridge and Policing Community Safety Partnership are sponsoring the ***Just One Life*** programme that challenges young drivers about the importance of behaving safely and acting responsibly when driving a car.

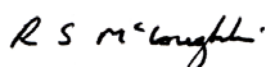
Our Year 13 and 14 pupils will attend the ***Just One Life*** event, 9.30 – 11.00am on Wednesday 15 November 2017 at Banbridge Leisure Centre. The pupils will walk to and from the event and be accompanied by members of staff.

The programme will focus attention on road traffic accidents and will feature contributions from a variety of key personnel who are routinely involved in dealing with road traffic accidents and their aftermath – **PSNI, NI Fire and Rescue Service, NI Ambulance Service, PSNI Family Liaison and Accident and Emergency.**

This is deliberately a hard hitting programme which aims to deliver a very serious message. As a consequence, the pupils present will be confronted with some graphic details which may be upsetting. St John Ambulance personnel will be present throughout the event to provide any assistance required. However, because of the direct nature of the event you may prefer that your son/daughter does not wish to attend and I request that you contact Mr McMullan (Head of Sixth Form) directly by letter to confirm that you do not wish your child to participate in this training event. In addition, the Policing Community Safety Partnership and Armagh, Banbridge and Craigavon Council have advised that they will be taking photographs and possibly a video at the event. Obviously we have previously sought parental consent for the use of images for school publication purposes, but you may wish your child not to be included in any of the ABC and/or PSCP photographs or videos. Your consent will remain valid unless you advise the school otherwise prior to the event.

I appreciate your co-operation and involvement in helping to educate your children about this potentially life-saving programme.
