

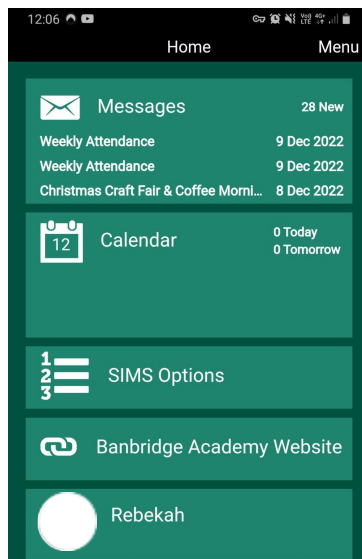
Parent Guide - Junior Winter Examination Results

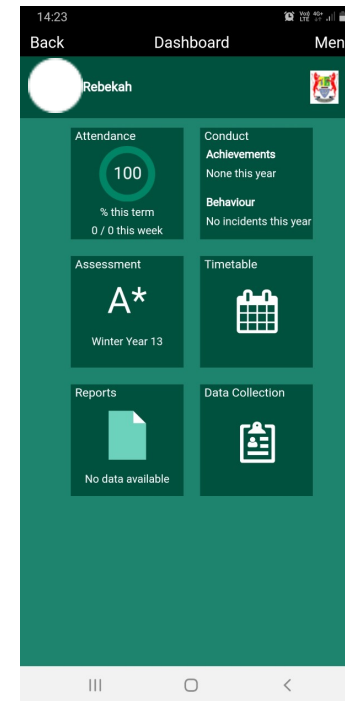
Accessing the Examination Results

Load the Parent App or Pupil App on your phone or tablet device. If you are experiencing problems accessing the App please refer to the school website at the address below:

From the Home screen please tap the name of the student.



On the pupil screen tap Assessment.

For each subject a Score(%), Year Average and Effort Level will be displayed.

You will need to scroll down to view all the information.

These Scores (%) and Grades are explained on the next page.

Understanding the Information

Results from the Winter Examinations will be made available in the Parent App as follows:

- Year 8 - Displayed Friday 3 February 2023 → Friday 28 April 2023
- Year 9 - Displayed Monday 6 February 2023 → Friday 28 April 2023
- Year 10 - Displayed Tuesday 7 February 2023 → Friday 28 April 2023

A full written report will be made available to parents at the end of the Academic Year.

For each subject the following information will be displayed:

- Score (%)
- Year Average (%)
- Effort Level

If your son/daughter missed an examination then 'Abs' will be displayed.

If your son/daughter missed the examination and sat the test late then an 'L' may be displayed below the Score (%).

Effort levels

A detailed explanation of each level is set out in the table on the next page. Please note subject teachers will award the Effort Level 3 to all pupils who are working well and doing all that is asked of them. An Effort Level 5 will only be awarded for exceptional students who have made an outstanding effort in all areas. Our aim is to provide pupils/guardians with accurate and useful information about their child's progress in school and to be able to recognise and acknowledge those students who are making an exceptional effort.
